FDH commercial plumbing inspections are done on all buildings new or existing in  
Fairfield county.

FDH residential plumbing inspections are done on new homes and/or new buildings  
with plumbing inside them (examples – barn or workshop) **and also** on residential  
homes or buildings built **on or after** March 1, 2006 that are having plumbing  
alterations done to the piping or fixtures such as remodeling or additions in  
Fairfield county.

Exception: If a building department (such as Bloom, Greenfield or Violet  
Township) requires a plumbing inspection on a residential remodel or  
addition on a residential building built **before** March 1, 2006 then FDH  
will provide that service.
