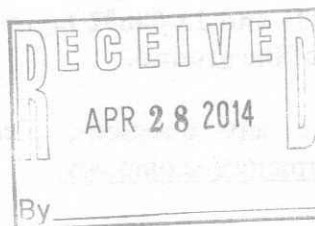

Re: Biosolids Site Review

Dear Mr. Daniels:

Ohio EPA received a request on March 28, 2014 from the Baltimore WWTP to include the following sites as part of the biosolids management program:

<u>Field ID</u>	<u>Ohio EPA Site #</u>	<u>County</u>	<u>Township</u>
Ridenour 1	23-00881	Fairfield	Greenfield
Ridenour 2	23-00882	Fairfield	Greenfield

These sites, owned and operated by Kenny Ridenour, are located at 4645 Carroll Eastern Rd.

A review of these sites was conducted by Ohio EPA. Consideration was given to soil and landscape characteristics, isolation distances from residences, geology and ground water conditions and the proximity to waterways and wells.

These sites are authorized to be included as part of the Baltimore WWTP biosolids program. This authorization is subject to conditions contained in both the NPDES permit and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-40. Conditions contained in the NPDES permit and OAC 3745-40 may differ. In such cases, the more restrictive conditions from either the NPDES permit or OAC 3745-40 shall govern.

Highlights of these conditions are as follows:

1. Biosolids shall not be applied in buffer zones.
2. In accordance with federal/state rules, biosolids may not be applied within 33 feet of surface waters of the state.
3. Biosolids application shall be timed to avoid periods of excessive wetness to help prevent runoff from a site.
4. Records for the application of biosolids on these sites shall be maintained in accordance with the requirements found in OAC 3745-40-09(C).



To minimize odors, Ohio EPA recommends that all biosolids beneficially used at Ohio EPA Sites 23-00881 and 23-00882 be immediately incorporated into the soil or injected beneath the surface of the ground.

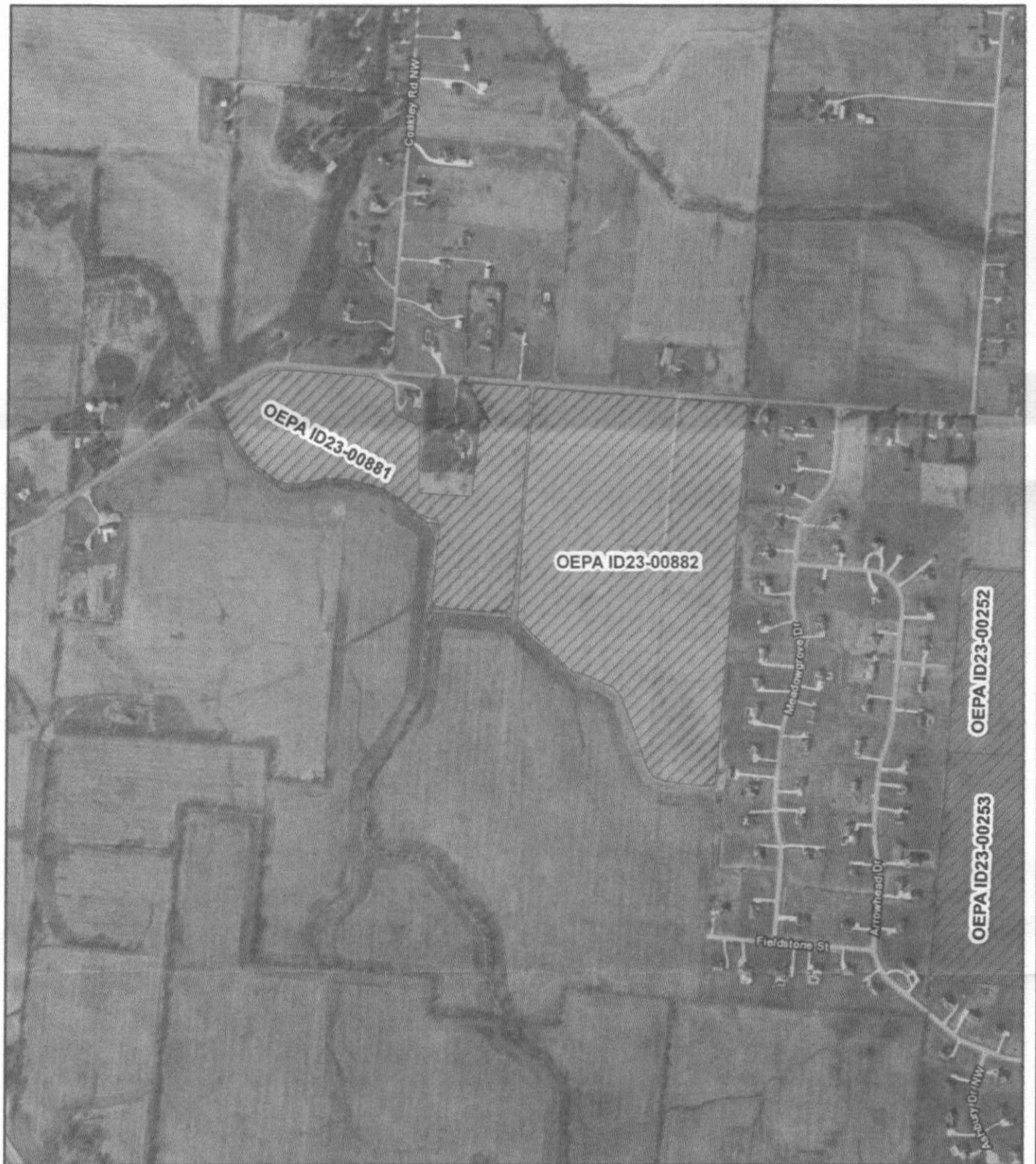
