Fairfield County Health Department Homeowner Permit Affidavit For Single Family Home

For health and safety reasons, the Fairfield County Health Department is committed to ensuring all plumbing is installed properly in accordance with the Ohio Plumbing Code. Plumbing work in Fairfield County is to be conducted by registered plumbing contractors or by the homeowner of a “house that he/she owns and resides”.

Homeowners may install their own plumbing if they own the property that is used or will be used as their primary residence. Otherwise, a plumbing contractor who is registered with the Health Department must do the plumbing work.

If you wish to install your own plumbing, please sign below and return this form with the completed Plumbing Permit Application.

I understand and will abide by the following statements:

- I will only use this dwelling as a home for me and my immediate family.
- I will not enter into a contract with an unlicensed contractor. It is understood that I may have assistance from other persons not licensed as contractors with Fairfield County, provided no contract either verbal or written exists among the parties involved.
- I have attached the permit application and isometrics.
- I will abide by all requirements as set forth in the Ohio Plumbing Code and the Fairfield Department of Health.
- I will be present for the underground (if needed), rough-in, and final plumbing inspections.
- I understand there is a fee for all reinspections and I am responsible for paying said fees prior to the reinspection.
- I understand that I may only apply for a permit once every two years for new construction.
