Under the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Grant, the Fairfield Department of Health (FDH) is required to notify the public on emergency planning activities.

All emergency response plans are reviewed, exercised and updated in such a manner that they are consistent with local, regional, state and federal regulations, standards and policies.
