The Ohio Department of Health has issued an order to limit or prohibit mass gatherings in the State of Ohio. The order states that **all public and private gatherings of greater than 10 people that are not members of the same household are prohibited.**

During this time, the residents of Fairfield County should limit non-essential activities as much as possible. It is advised that residents should decrease in person interactions with non-household members. Residents need to limit attending gatherings of any number, especially indoors where it can be more difficult to maintain social distancing. Outdoor activities can be conducted because they generally allow for more social distancing, but mask wearing and limiting the size of the gathering are still essential.

At this time, the Fairfield Department of Health does not support any indoor activities that encourage the gathering of individuals that are not living in the same household. The Fairfield Department of Health does not approve or support any plans for indoor sports at this time.
